



Corfu Airport to LUXURY VILLA JUPITER in Agios Spyridon of Peritheia

GPS coordinates: Latitude: 39.814099 | Longitude: 19.868247

We hope you have had a pleasant trip so far. Please find below instructions to help you find your villa, which will be available for you to enter at 16.00.

Important note: Some car hire companies will not always give you a car with a full tank. So, before you start driving, we recommend you check your petrol. The nearest petrol station along your route to the Villa, is just after step 4, when you turn on to the dual carriageway at approx. 7kms.

Approximate driving time: 70 min.

Step	Kms	Instructions
1	0 kms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At the exit of the airport turn Right. You will pass through a residential area before reaching a junction with traffic lights at the sea.
2	1 kms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Turn Left at the sea and continue along this road keeping the sea on your right this area is known as Garitsa. You will pass the 'Corfu Palace' hotel on your left, the park and the old town on your left, and the Old Fortress to the right before passing under an arch of the palace of St Michael and George.
3	2.5 kms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Continuing along the same road you will pass the old port on the right, the New Fortress on the left, the commercial harbour (take care not to enter the slip road to the port) and then a long strip of discos and bars. The road runs alongside the sea all the way.
4	6.5 kms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shortly after the last of the discos you will come to a large T-junction with traffic lights. Turn Right following the signs for Paleokastritsa. NB: these lights have a slip road onto the main dual- carriageway. When they flash amber proceed with extreme caution as traffic may still be coming from the left. When they are red, stop. Continue along the dual carriage way through several sets of traffic lights. Just beyond the 'Park Hotel' on the left which has a full sized boat outside it you will come to traffic lights at a busy junction. Continue straight ahead past a big orange building on the left hand corner, following signs to Sidari.
5	12 kms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You are now on the main central road to the North of the island. You will drive along this road until you get to the next major junction. Signs for Paleokastritsa lead to the left. Turn Right following signs for Sidari, Karousades, Acharavi.
6	16.1 kms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Continue to follow this road for approximately the next ten km past the village of Skripero and one of the few sets of traffic lights on the island. You will then start to ascend up the central mountain range of Corfu with stunning bird's eye views down the whole length of the island. At the crest of the hill you will drive through the small village of Troumbeta and start the descent into the Northern side with spectacular views of the small north coastal islands.
7	25.9 kms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will now come to a junction with a road turning right at a sharp angle signposted Roda 15, Choroepiskopi 2, Acharavi 18. Turn right here. After 400m you should see a Shell Petrol station on your left and a large Titan quarry on your right to indicate you are on the right road. Follow this

		descending road for another couple of km until you arrive at the next junction.
8	27.6 kms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You are now at a T junction with a pink shop building signed TZAMIA KATΩMEPHΣ ahead of you. Turn Right here following signs for Karousades and Acharavi. The road continues to descend through the olive groves, until you come to a few buildings, then go over a small bridge.
9	30.1 kms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You are now at a junction with two options for Acharavi! Turn left following signs for Acharavi, Karousades, Agrafoi and Agnos. This is a less windy road that flattens out as it takes you past an EKO petrol station on your right. You can see the old village of Karousades strething along the hill top in front of you. Continue along this road as it ascends again to the next junction. Turn right here following signs for Acharavi 9km and Roda 6km
10	31.4 kms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> .Continue along this road as it slopes downwards and continue until you pass two petrol stations, one on either side. This is a flat country road that brings you to the main Roda junction. You have to come to a main road with a betting shop and a butcher's ahead of you. To your left is the main set of traffic lights. Turn left at the junction and then right again at the lights with an optical shop on your right corner, following the sign for Acharavi.
11	36 kms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You are now on the main road stretching along the north coast of the island heading East towards the town of Acharavi. Drive through the center of Acharavi and past the roundabout. This is a good place for shopping and any provisions you may need. Continue along this road, past Gelina Village, Hydropolis water theme park and Shell petrol station on your left. After approximately 4.6km you will come across the sign for Agios Spyridon on your left handside . Turn left and follow this road downhill for approx. 1,3km until you can see the beach and Hellas traditional tavern on your right. Turn right , just before the tavern and follow the beach road for about 250m. You will find our beautiful Pyramid restaurant on the right and our Lobby bar next door.
12	41.5 kms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Drive past our Pyramid restaurant, at the end of the beach road, follow the road to the right slightly up hill, count 3 buildings on your left hand side and at the top of the road, you will find Luxury Villa Jupiter on your left hand side. The key box is on the left of the electric gate. Please bear in mind that the gate opens outwards so be careful not to park too close to the gate.

A few things to remember:

- Drive on the right.
- Distances mentioned above are approximate.
- Always carry your car hire documents, passport and driving license when driving.
- As a precaution we recommend you purchase mosquito repellent prior to your first night.
- We recommend that you do not take unnecessary valuables or large amounts of cash with you
- Key box code : Do not forget to note this somewhere safe and do not give this information to anyone else.
- We also recommend for you to download the free app: **maps.me** . You can download the maps for Greece and use it on your smart phone. Once the maps are download there is no necessity for internet access for you to be able to use it. On this app you can search for your villa by name follow audio directions if this is something you prefer.
- The villa gate is electric. On the key remote just keep A pressed for a few seconds and the gate will open outwards. Repeat for closing the gate.
